# Rodeo Finn by Clare O'Beara






# Different and Same REY Venn Diagram



flat, thin	padded under saddle so horse doesn't need a blanket	heavy
long saddle flaps	lightweight, hornless, steel cantle and pommel	have a horn
double steel reinforcement to avoid injuring horse withers	full side flaps usually set forward	often front cinch only
